Note by the President of the Security Council

At its 5674th meeting, held on 24 March 2007 in connection with the item entitled “Non-proliferation”, the Security Council adopted resolution 1747 (2007).

In paragraph 12 of the resolution, the Security Council requested within 60 days a further report from the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) on “whether Iran has established full and sustained suspension of all activities mentioned in resolution 1737 (2006), as well as on the process of Iranian compliance with all the steps required by the IAEA Board and with the other provisions of resolution 1737 (2006) and of this resolution, to the IAEA Board of Governors and in parallel to the Security Council for its consideration”.

Accordingly, the President hereby circulates the report received today from IAEA (see annex).
