Letter dated 8 July 2010 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1928 (2010), by which the Council decided to extend until 12 June 2011 the mandate of the Panel of Experts, as specified in paragraph 26 of resolution 1874 (2009), and requested the Secretary-General to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006), I have reappointed the following experts:

- Mr. Masahiko Asada, Japan (nuclear issues);
- Mr. David J. Birch, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (proliferation of weapons of mass destruction);
- Mr. Victor D. Comras, United States of America (finance);
- Mr. Erik Marzolf, France (missile technology);
- Mr. Young-wan Song, Republic of Korea (regional issues);
- Mr. Alexander Vilnin, Russian Federation (customs);
- Mr. Xiaodong Xue, China (export control, nuclear items).

I have designated Mr. David J. Birch to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
