Letter dated 4 August 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI), which was established on 14 August 2003 in accordance with Security Council resolution 1500 (2003).

Following the usual consultations, I would like to inform you of my intention to appoint Mr. Martin Kobler (Germany) as my Special Representative and Head of UNAMI.

Mr. Kobler will replace Mr. Ad Melkert (the Netherlands) who has served in Iraq for over two years. I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation for Mr. Melkert's leadership of UNAMI in implementing its mandate under Security Council resolution 1770 (2007) and subsequent resolutions.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
