Letter dated 6 June 2013 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO), established by the Security Council in its resolution 1925 (2010) of 28 May 2010 and most recently extended by resolution 2098 (2013) of 28 March 2013.

Following the usual consultations, I would like to inform you of my intention to appoint Martin Kobler (Germany) as my Special Representative for the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Head of MONUSCO. He replaces Roger Meece (United States of America), who will complete his assignment in July. I would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to Mr. Meece for his dedication and effective leadership of MONUSCO.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
