Letter dated 21 May 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2153 (2014) concerning Côte d'Ivoire. By paragraph 24 of the resolution, the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Group of Experts until 30 May 2015 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures.
