Letter dated 31 October 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

By its resolution 2006 (2011) of 14 September 2011, the Security Council reappointed Hassan Bubacar Jallow as Prosecutor of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. Pursuant to that resolution, the term of office of Mr. Jallow will come to an end on 31 December 2014.

According to article 15, paragraph 4, of the Statute of the International Tribunal, the Prosecutor is appointed by the Security Council on nomination by the Secretary-General.

In this regard, I hereby nominate Mr. Jallow and request that the Security Council reappoint him as Prosecutor of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. Given the projection of the President of the Tribunal, Judge Vagn Joensen in regard to the completion of the work of the Tribunal in 2015, I suggest that you, and through you the Council, consider the extension of the appointment of Mr. Jallow for a term with effect from 1 January 2015 until 31 December 2015, subject to an earlier termination by the Council upon the completion of the work of the International Tribunal.
