Letter dated 5 February 2014 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2111 \(2013\)](#), adopted by the Council on 24 July 2013. In paragraph 27 of the resolution, the Council requested the Secretary-General to re-establish the Monitoring Group on Somalia and Eritrea for a period of 16 months, consisting of eight experts, drawing, as appropriate, on the expertise of the members of the Monitoring Group established pursuant to resolutions [2060 \(2012\)](#), [2002 \(2011\)](#) and [1916 \(2010\)](#) and consistent with resolution [1907 \(2009\)](#), in order to fulfil its mandate.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, in view of the resignation of Cornelis Steenken, arms expert for Eritrea, I have appointed the following arms expert to serve on the Monitoring Group: Joakim Gundel (Denmark).

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
