Letter dated 7 December 2016 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS), established by the Security Council in its resolution 1996 (2011), and most recently extended by the Council in its resolution 2304 (2016).

Following the usual consultations, I would like to inform you of my intention to appoint Mr. David Shearer (New Zealand) as my Special Representative for South Sudan and Head of UNMISS. I would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to Ms. Løj for her dedication and effective leadership.
