**Letter dated 12 May 2016 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 12 of Security Council resolution 2278 (2016) concerning Libya, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya established pursuant to resolution 1973 (2011) until 31 July 2017.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya, I have appointed the following experts:

- Mr. Naji Abou-Khalil, Lebanon (armed groups/regional)
- Mr. Moncef Kartas, Tunisia (arms)
- Mr. David McFarland, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (arms)
- Mr. Juan Alberto Pintos Servia, Spain (maritime/transport)
- Mr. Steven Spittaels, Belgium (finance)

I have also designated Mr. Spittaels to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

An expert on armed groups will be appointed in due course.

I should be grateful if you would bring the present letter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
