Letter dated 28 February 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution [2399 \(2018\)](#), by which the Security Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on the Central African Republic until 28 February 2019.
