Letter dated 10 July 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2418 \(2018\)](#), adopted on 31 May 2018, concerning South Sudan, by which the Council decided to extend until 14 August 2018 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on South Sudan as set out in paragraph 12 of resolution [2290 \(2016\)](#).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2206 \(2015\)](#) concerning South Sudan, I have administratively extended the appointments and contracts of the following experts until 14 August 2018:

Mr. Andrews Atta-Asamoah, regional issues (Ghana)
Mr. Andrei Kolmakov, natural resources/finance (Russian Federation)
Ms. Anna Oosterlinck, humanitarian affairs (Belgium)
Mr. Colin Thomas-Jensen, armed groups (United States of America)

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
