Letter dated 20 August 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2428 \(2018\)](#), by which the Council decided to extend until 1 July 2019 the mandate of the Panel of Experts on South Sudan, as set out in paragraph 18 of Council resolution [2206 \(2015\)](#) and paragraph 19 of resolution [2428 \(2018\)](#).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2206 \(2015\)](#) concerning South Sudan, I have appointed the following experts to serve on the Panel until 1 July 2019:

Mr. Michael Gibb, natural resources (Norway)
Mr. Dean Gillespie, arms (South Africa)
Mr. Andrei Kolmakov, finance (Russian Federation)
Ms. Renifa Madenga, humanitarian affairs (Zimbabwe)
Mr. Emilio Manfredi, armed groups/regional issues (Italy)

I have designated Mr. Gibb to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
