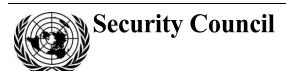

## Letter dated 26 November 2019 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

I am writing with reference to the letter dated 19 November 2019 contained in document S/2019/895, wherein the representative of the Israeli regime, by putting together certain dates, names and data in pursuance of its policy to spread disinformation against the Islamic Republic of Iran, has accused my country of violating resolution 2231 (2015) of the Security Council.

As is its usual practice when the Secretariat begins drafting the related report of the Secretary-General, the representative of that regime disseminates fabrications against Iran for their inclusion in that report.

As such a fabrication has nothing to do with annex B to resolution 2231 (2015), its inclusion in the reports of the Secretary-General on that resolution would lead only to the dissemination of false allegations exploiting the United Nations resources and established mechanism, thus undermining the quality and credibility of such reports.

Iran has neither launched any missile nor conducted any other action inconsistent with annex B to resolution 2231 (2015). Therefore, the fabricated information and accusations contained in that letter are hereby strongly rejected.

Furthermore, I would also like to make it clear that, through such allegations and the systematic dissemination of disinformation against the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Israeli regime is unsuccessfully attempting to divert attention from the threat posed to regional peace and security emanating from its expansionist policy, as well as brutal practices and crimes.

Moreover, it is ironic that the Israeli regime calls for the implementation of Security Council resolution 2231 (2015) – a resolution that it has publicly opposed and repeatedly violated. Therefore, this regime should be held accountable for such violations and be compelled to stop violating it.

Seizing this opportunity, I would also like to reject the fabricated information contained in the letter dated 12 November 2019 of the aforementioned regime (S/2019/874).

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
