

Letter dated 16 December 2019 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 29 of Security Council resolution 2498 (2019), by which the Council renewed the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Somalia until 15 December 2020.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolution 751 (1992) concerning Somalia, I have appointed the following experts:

Ms. Nazanine Moshiri, armed groups (Islamic Republic of Iran)

Mr. Brian O'Sullivan, armed groups/natural resources (Ireland)

Mr. Matthew Rosbottom, finance (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)

Mr. Richard Zabot, arms (France)

I have designated Ms. Hryckow to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

The remaining expert (humanitarian affairs) will be appointed as soon as possible.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
