**Letter dated 16 December 2019 from the Secretary-General  
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 29 of Security Council resolution [2498 \(2019\)](#), by which the Council renewed the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Somalia until 15 December 2020.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolution [751 \(1992\)](#) concerning Somalia, I have appointed the following experts:

Ms. Nazanine Moshiri, armed groups (Islamic Republic of Iran)  
Mr. Brian O'Sullivan, armed groups/natural resources (Ireland)  
Mr. Matthew Rosbottom, finance (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)  
Mr. Richard Zobot, arms (France)

I have designated Ms. Hryckow to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.

The remaining expert (humanitarian affairs) will be appointed as soon as possible.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
