Letter dated 28 January 2020 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1646 (2005), adopted on 20 December 2005, in which the Council, in keeping with its resolution 1645 (2005), adopted on the same date, decided that the permanent members listed in Article 23, paragraph 1, of the Charter of the United Nations should be members of the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission and that, in addition, the Council should select two of its elected members per year to participate in the Organizational Committee.

I therefore have the honour to inform you that, following informal consultations, the members of the Security Council have agreed on the selection of the Dominican Republic and the Niger as the two elected members of the Council to participate in the Organizational Committee for a term of one year, until the end of 2020.
