

Position of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) regarding the recommendation contained in the thirteenth report of the Analytical Support and Sanctions Monitoring Team

1. On 28 April 2022, the Analytical Support and Sanctions Monitoring Team submitted its thirteenth report (S/2022/419) to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011). The Committee is of the opinion that all Member States should be made aware of the Monitoring Team's recommendation and the position of the Committee on it.

Specific recommendation related to the travel ban and exemption procedures

2. In paragraph 91 of its thirteenth report, the Monitoring Team recommended that the Committee write to all Member States recalling their obligations, should they host Taliban delegations, to implement the travel ban as described in Security Council resolution 2255 (2015) and to comply with the exemption procedures and the Committee's reporting requirements regarding travel of sanctioned individuals. The Committee agreed that the Chair, on behalf of the Committee, would write to Member States recalling their obligations, should they host Taliban delegations, to implement the travel ban as described in Security Council resolution 2255 (2015) and to comply with the exemption procedures and the Committee's reporting requirements regarding travel of sanctioned individuals.
