NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 73rd plenary meeting of its forty-third sussion, on 7 December 1988, the General Assembly adopted resolution 43/76, entitled, "Review and implementation of the Concluding Document of the Twelfth Special Session of the General Assembly". 1/

2. In paragraphs 1 and 3 of resolution 43/76 A, the General Assembly:

"1. <u>Cells upon</u> the Security Council, in particular its permanent members, within the framework of its main task, to contribute to establishing and maintaining international **peace** and security with the least possible diversion of world human and economic resources to armament, and to take tho *necessary* steps for the effective implementation of Article 26 of the Charter of the United Nations with a view to enhancing the central role of the United Nations in facilitating solutions to the issues of arms limitation, primarily in the nuclear field, and disarmament, as well as the strengthening of international peace and security;

"...

"3. **<u>Recommends</u>** that the Security Council consider the question of establishing, under Article 29 of the Charter, such subsidiary bodies as it deems necessary for the performance of its functions to facilitate a solution to diaarmament issues ."
