Cuba: revised draft resolution

The Security Council,

Reaffirming its faith in fundamental human rights, in the dignity and worth of the human person, in the equal rights of men and women and of nations large and small,

Recalling its resolutions 660 (1990), 661 (1990), 662 (1990), 664 (1990) and 665 (1990),

Recalling further subparagraph C of paragraph 3, and paragraph 4 of resolution 661 (1990), and deeply concerned about the safety and well-being of the civilian population and of the foreign residents in Iraq and Kuwait,

- 1. Declares that the access to basic foodstuffs and to adequate medical assistance is a fundamental human right to be protected under all circumstances;**
- 2. Decides that, in accordance with the above principle, under no circumstance shall actions be taken, including those resulting from the implementation of Security Council decisions such as resolutions 661 (1990) and 665 (1990), that may hinder access of the civilian population and the foreign nationals in Iraq and Kuwait to basic foodstuffs, medical supplies and medical assistance;**
- 3. Requests the Secretary-General to keep the Council permanently informed about the implementation of this resolution.**
