## STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

The following statement is circulated in connexion with the report by the Secretary-General on the observation of the cease-fire in the Suez Canal sector (S/8053/Add.3). After consultations I have had with the representatives, I understand there is no objection to my transmittal of this statement as reflecting the view of the members of the Council:

As regards document S/8053/Add.3, brought to the attention of the Security Council, the members, recalling the consensus reached at its 1366th meeting on 9 July 1967, recognize the necessity of the enlargement by the Secretary-General of the number of observers in the Sucz Canal zone and the provision of additional technical material and means of transportation.
