National report on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1896 (2009)

On 8 April 2010, the President of the Federative Republic of Brazil, in use of the competence established in article 84, IV, of the Brazilian Constitution, signed Decree 7.149/2010,* which incorporates Security Council resolution 1896 (2009) into the national legislation. Decree 7.149/2010 was published on 9 April 2010 and entered into force immediately. Its annex contains a complete transcription of Security Council resolution 1896 (2009).

According to article 1 of the above-mentioned Decree, all national authorities are obliged to implement the measures set forth in resolution 1896 (2009), pursuant to the criteria previously established in Security Council resolutions 1596 (2005), 1649 (2005), 1698 (2006), 1771 (2007), 1804 (2008), 1807 (2008) and 1857 (2008), which were incorporated into national legislation through Decrees 5.489/2005, 5.696/2006, 5.936/2006, 6.358/2008, 6.569/2008, 6.570/2008 and 6.851/2009.
