Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo

Note verbale dated 26 September 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Colombia to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Colombia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and takes this opportunity to provide information on the steps taken by Colombia to implement the measures imposed by resolution 1952 (2010).

With regard to the actions undertaken by Colombia to implement the measures adopted in paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 8 of resolution 1952 (2010), the Permanent Mission of Colombia wishes to report that:

Colombia has transmitted to the competent national authorities the relevant Security Council resolutions concerning sanctions imposed on the Democratic Republic of the Congo, with the request that they take the necessary measures for the implementation of those resolutions.

Colombia has set up an inter-agency committee for the purpose of examining the requirements set out in the sanctions resolutions adopted by the United Nations Security Council, promoting domestic compliance with those resolutions and providing follow-up. The committee has taken the form of a standing body for consultation, exchange of information and technical assistance on matters relating to the various types of sanctions imposed by the Security Council. The members of the committee are:

Colombia's military industry, in resolutions 267 of 2004 and 079 of 2011, adopted the necessary measures to comply with the provisions of the resolutions adopted by the United Nations Security Council concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

With regard to measures relating to the arms embargo, to date the national Government has not received any information about arms embargo procedures implemented in accordance with the relevant Security Council resolutions concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

To date, the national Government has not received any information about requests for entry into or transit through the national territory from persons designated in the annexes to the Security Council resolutions or in their updated lists.
