National report of Brazil on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2021 (2011)

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations has the honour to present its national report on the actions taken to implement the measures imposed by resolution 2021 (2011) regarding the Democratic Republic of the Congo, in accordance with paragraph 19 of that resolution.

On 6 February 2012, the President of the Federative Republic of Brazil signed Decree 7.677/2012,* which incorporates Security Council resolution 2021 (2011) into the national legislation. Decree 7.677/2012 was published on 7 February 2012 and entered into force immediately. Its annex contains a complete transcription of resolution 2021 (2011).

According to article 1 of the above-mentioned Decree, all national authorities must implement the measures set forth in resolution 2021 (2011) — arms embargo, assets freeze and travel ban — pursuant to the criteria previously established in Security Council resolutions 1807 (2008) and 1857 (2008), which were incorporated into the national legislation through Decrees 6.570/2008 and 6.851/2009.
