**Security Council Committee established pursuant  
to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan****Note verbale dated 22 June 2005 from the Permanent Mission  
of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman  
of the Committee**

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005), concerning Darfur, Sudan, and has the honour to inform the Committee that the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil has adopted the necessary measures in compliance with the sanctions regime established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1591 (2005).

Accordingly, resolution 1591 (2005) and resolution 1556 (2004) were incorporated into the national legislation, respectively, by decrees 5470, of 16 June 2005, and 5451, of 1 June 2005, which entered into force on the date of their issuance.

In accordance with the above-mentioned legislation, the Brazilian authorities must comply with the provisions of both resolutions adopted by the Security Council, within the limits of their duties and powers, which include the provisions related to the arms embargo, asset freeze and travel ban.
