The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1591 (2005) concerning the Sudan and wishes to communicate the following.

Liechtenstein has fully implemented the arms embargo, travel restrictions and asset freeze provided by Security Council resolutions 1556 (2004) and 1591 (2005). The relevant measures were incorporated into national law through the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning the Sudan, and violations are punishable in accordance with criminal law. Furthermore, by virtue of its customs union with Switzerland, the relevant Swiss laws and enforcement measures are applied with respect to the movements of goods and persons across the borders of Liechtenstein as well.
