Report of Albania on the implementation of Security Council resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013), 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016)

Albania is convinced that full compliance with Security Council resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013), 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016) by all Member States will serve to reinforce peace and security in the world.

In order to effectively comply with the aforementioned resolutions, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Albania has circulated the full texts of Security Council resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013), 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016) to all relevant institutions in Albania, along with a request for complete and effective implementation of their provisions to the fullest extent.

Pursuant to the calls by the Security Council for the effective implementation of the restrictive measures already in place, the following institutions, among others, have been notified in a timely manner, and repeatedly reminded, of the provisions of resolutions 1718 (2006), 1874 (2009), 2087 (2013), 2094 (2013), 2270 (2016) and 2321 (2016), by means of which the Council has imposed sanctions relating to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea: the Ministry of Interior, the Ministry of Finance (the General Directorate for the Prevention of Money Laundering), the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Energy, the General Directorate of Customs and the Civil Aviation Authority.

Albania would also like to emphasize that, according to official statistics, there have been no commercial and/or human interactions or exchanges whatsoever with the Democratic People's Republic of Korea during the past decade, including during the reporting period.

Albania will continue to fully comply with the provisions and requirements provided for in the above-mentioned resolutions.
