Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya

Note verbale dated 17 June 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Liechtenstein to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and has the honour to refer to the note of 25 March 2011, requesting all States to report to the Committee on their implementation of paragraphs 9, 10, 15 and 17 of resolution 1970 (2011).

Liechtenstein is fully committed to the implementation of the measures, including those calling upon States to impose the arms embargo, the travel ban and the assets freeze. The measures referred to in paragraphs 9, 10, 15 and 17 of resolution 1970 (2011) were incorporated into national law in March 2011 through the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2011, No. 81) and further amendments thereto (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2011, Nos. 82, 92, 115, 120, 133, 143, 195 and 225). Liechtenstein furthermore incorporated the additional restrictive measures of the European Union. By virtue of its Customs Union with Switzerland, the relevant Swiss laws and enforcement measures are applied with respect to the movements of goods and persons across Liechtenstein's borders.
