Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya

Letter dated 5 July 2011 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Turkey to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

In accordance with Security Council resolutions 1970 (2011) and 1973 (2011) and with reference to your letter dated 21 June 2011, in which States Members of the United Nations are reminded to inform the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya of the steps they have taken with a view to implementing effectively paragraphs 9, 10, 15 and 17 of the resolution cited above, I have the pleasure to provide you with the information below.

The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Turkey, with a view to implementing Security Council resolutions 1970 (2011) and 1973 (2011), has adopted a common decision (2011/2001) on 21 June 2011, in which all the obligations stemming from articles 9, 10, 15 and 17 of resolution 1970 (2011) and paragraphs 6, 7, 8, 9, 11 (no fly zone), 13-16 (enforcement of arms embargo), 17, 18 (ban on flights) and 19-21 (asset freeze) of resolution 1973 (2011) have been scrupulously depicted.

With the decision of the Council of Ministers referred to above, all the obligations stipulated in Security Council resolutions 1970 (2011) and 1973 (2011) have been incorporated into Turkish legislation and thus have immediate binding effect upon all domestic ministries, agencies and institutes, as well as with individuals.

Furthermore, in accordance with the decision of the Council of Ministers, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has been accorded the authority to coordinate the full, effective and timely implementation of the decision.
