Report of India on the implementation of Security Council resolutions 1970 (2011), 1973 (2011), 2009 (2011), 2016 (2011) and 2017 (2011)

The Government of India published an Order dated 20 June 2016 on the implementation of Security Council resolutions on Libya in the Gazette of India.¹ The Order was published in order to incorporate into Indian domestic law the sanctions against Libya established by the Security Council in its resolutions 1970 (2011), 1973 (2011), 2009 (2011), 2016 (2011) and 2017 (2011). The Order implements all sanctions against Libya.

Arms embargo

The Order prevents the direct or indirect supply, sale or transfer to the Libyan authorities, or Libya, from or through Indian territory or by Indian nationals, or using Indian flag vessels or aircraft, of arms and related materiel of all types, including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment, paramilitary equipment and spare parts for the aforementioned, and technical assistance, training, financial or other assistance related to military activities, or the provision, maintenance or use of any arms and related materiel, including the provision of armed mercenary personnel whether or not they originate in Indian territory. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolutions.

Travel ban

The Order prevents the entry into or transit through the territory of India of individuals listed in annex I to resolution 1970 (2011) or designated by the Committee, while providing that the Government of India is not obligated to refuse its own nationals entry into its territory. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolutions.

Asset freeze

The Order provides for the freezing without delay of all funds, other financial assets and economic resources located in India which are owned or controlled, directly or indirectly, by individuals or entities listed in annex II to resolution 1970 (2011) or designated by the Committee, or by individuals or entities acting on their behalf or at their direction, or by entities owned or controlled by them, and ensures that any funds, financial assets or economic resources are prevented from being made available by Indian nationals, or by any individuals or entities within the territory of India, to or for the benefit of individuals or entities designated by the Committee. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolutions.

Illicit export of crude oil

The Order prevents any Indian flag vessel designated by the Committee from loading, transporting or discharging crude oil from Libya; prevents vessels designated by the Committee from entering Indian ports; prohibits the provision by Indian nationals or from Indian territory of bunkering services, such as the provision of fuel or supplies or other services to vessels designated by the Committee; and prevents

Indian nationals and entities and individuals in Indian territory from engaging in any financial transactions with regard to crude oil from Libya aboard vessels designated by the Committee. Exemptions are provided in accordance with the above-mentioned resolutions.
