Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) concerning Guinea-Bissau

Note verbale dated 2 August 2012 from the Permanent Mission of Estonia to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Estonia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) and, according to the provisions of paragraph 10 of the resolution, would like to convey the following.

Estonia implements Security Council resolutions through European Union corresponding legislation — Council decisions and regulations.

On 31 May 2012, the Council of the European Union adopted Council decision 2012/285/CFSP, concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies threatening the peace, security or stability of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau, which implemented Security Council resolution 2048 (2012).

Council decision 2012/285/CFSP consists of the following measures:

- Restrictions on admission
- Freezing of funds and economic resources.

Estonia implements restrictive measures on admission by governmental order No. 37, adopted on 27 January 2011. The freezing of funds and economic resources is implemented by Council implementing regulation No. 458/2012.

In order to observe and implement the international sanctions imposed by Council decision 2012/285/CFSP, the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Estonia has informed all competent Estonian authorities of the provisions in Security Council resolution 2048 (2012).
