

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014)

Note verbale dated 18 March 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Liechtenstein to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Representative of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014) and has the honour to refer to the note of 11 March 2015 requesting all States to report to the Committee on their implementation of paragraphs 11 and 15 of resolution 2140 (2014).

Liechtenstein is fully committed to the implementation of those measures, including those calling upon States to impose a travel ban and an assets freeze. The measures referred to in paragraphs 11 (assets freeze) and 15 (travel ban) of resolution 2140 (2014) were incorporated into national law in November 2014 through the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning Yemen (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2014, No. 293) and in December 2014 through further amendments thereto (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2014, No. 311).
