Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014)

Note verbale dated 7 July 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Italy to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Italy to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014) and has the honour to inform the Chair, in response to the note verbale dated 11 March 2015, that, pursuant to paragraph 9 of Security Council resolution 2204 (2015), in which the Council called upon all Member States to report to the Committee within 90 days of the adoption of the resolution on the steps they have taken with a view to implementing effectively the measures imposed by resolution 2140 (2014):

(a) Resolution 2140 (2014) is implemented in Italy through the following European Union legislation, fully mandatory and directly applicable:

- (i) Council decision 2014/932/CFSP of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen;¹
- (ii) Council regulation (EU) No. 1352/2014 of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen;²

(b) The Italian Financial Security Committee has informed the Italian Foreign Ministry that so far no assets and financial resources belonging to persons or entities listed in accordance with the aforementioned Security Council resolutions have been frozen in Italy.
