
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Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014)

Note verbale dated 2 July 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Kazakhstan to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014) concerning Yemen, the mandate of which was expanded in paragraph 20 of resolution 2216 (2015), and has the honour to submit the national action plan of the Republic of Kazakhstan to implement resolution 2216 (2015).

National plan of action of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the implementation of Security Council resolution 2216 (2015)

The Ministry of Investment and Development, the Ministry of Defence and the National Security Committee of the Republic of Kazakhstan shall take the necessary measures to prevent the direct or indirect supply, sale or transfer to, or for the benefit of Ali Abdullah Saleh, Abdullah Yahya Al-Hakim, Abd Al-Khaliq Al-Huthi, and the individuals and entities designated by the Committee established pursuant to paragraph 19 of resolution 2140 (2014) pursuant to paragraph 20 (d) of resolution 2216 (2015), the individuals and entities listed in the annex of resolution 2216 (2015), and those acting on their behalf or at their direction in Yemen, from or through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan or by nationals of the Republic of Kazakhstan, or using the flag vessels or aircraft of the Republic of Kazakhstan, of arms and related materiel of all types, including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment, paramilitary equipment, and spare parts for the aforementioned, and technical assistance, training, financial or other assistance, related to military activities or the maintenance or use of any arms and related materiel.

The Ministry of Finance and the National Security Committee of the Republic of Kazakhstan shall inspect all cargo to Yemen, if there is information that provides reasonable grounds to believe that the cargo contains items the supply, sale or transfer of which is prohibited pursuant to paragraph 14 of resolution 2216 (2015) for the purpose of ensuring strict implementation of those provisions.

Upon the discovery of items, the supply, sale or transfer of which is prohibited pursuant to paragraph 14 of resolution 2216 (2015), such items shall be seized and disposed of (such as through destruction, rendering inoperable, storage or transferring to a State other than the originating or destination States for disposal).

The Ministry of Finance, the National Security Committee, the Ministry of Defence and the Ministry of Investment and Development shall report within 24 hours to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan all relevant facts and all actions undertaken in response, as provided for in this plan of action.

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
