Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014)

Note verbale dated 14 April 2015 from the Permanent Mission of Estonia to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Estonia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014) and has the honour to refer to the note verbale dated 11 March 2015. The Mission submits herewith the following report on the steps taken with a view to implementing effectively paragraphs 11 (asset freeze) and 15 (travel ban) of resolution 2140 (2014).

In Estonia, the asset freeze is implemented in accordance with article 2 of Council of the European Union Decision 2014/932/CFSP of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen. The measures are implemented by articles 2 to 10 of the directly applicable Council of the European Union Regulation (EU) No. 1352/2014 of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen.

The travel ban is implemented in accordance with article 1 of Council of the European Union Decision 2014/932/CFSP of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen. This Decision is implemented by an administrative measure that prevents the entry into or transit through Estonian territory by the designated persons. The administrative measure has been imposed by the Government of the Republic of Estonia by its order No. 579 of 18 December 2014 regarding the implementation of the restrictive measures imposed in view of the situation in Yemen. The travel ban is implemented in accordance with the Obligation to Leave and Prohibition on Entry Act of Estonia.

Infringements of the international sanctions imposed by international organizations are punishable in accordance with article 93¹ of the Penal Code of Estonia.
