

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014)

## Note verbale dated 29 December 2020 from the Permanent Mission of Norway to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

Pursuant to paragraphs 11 and 15 of resolution 2140 (2014) and paragraph 10 of resolution 2266 (2016), the Permanent Mission of Norway to the United Nations has the honour to provide the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014) with the following information on the steps taken with a view to implementing effectively the measures imposed by those resolutions.

On 19 June 2015, the Norwegian Regulation on Sanctions against Certain Persons and Actors in Yemen, No. 663, was adopted. It includes provisions on the freezing of the funds and economic resources of listed persons and entities that are designated by the Security Council or the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 (2014).

The designation of persons and entities made by the Security Council or the Sanctions Committee is automatically in force in Norway through a hyperlink to the Sanctions Committee's lists.

In addition to the above-mentioned regulation, some of the elements in resolutions 2140 (2014) and 2266 (2016) are covered by other pieces of Norwegian legislation.

The arms embargoes imposed in Security Council resolutions are implemented at the national level by virtue of Norway's Export Control Act and Export Control Regulations.

Regarding restrictions on admissions and travel restrictions, pursuant to the Act of 24 June 1988, No. 64, concerning the entry of foreign nationals into the Kingdom of Norway and their presence in the realm (Immigration Act), the Norwegian Directorate of Immigration is instructed to prevent the entry into, or the transit through, Norwegian territory of all persons who have been designated by the Security Council or the Committee. The relevant national authorities have been instructed to follow up on the above-mentioned restrictions.

Please be assured that Norway will take an active approach to ensuring the effective implementation of the provisions of the resolutions.
