Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan

Note verbale dated 28 February 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2206 (2015) concerning South Sudan and has the honour to transmit a copy of the updated Gazette of Pakistan Statutory Notifications for Statutory Regulatory Order (S.R.O.) No. 620 (I)/2016, dated 16 July 2016.* The Order contains notifications on travel restrictions, the arms embargo and the freezing of funds and other financial assets or economic resources of individuals and entities issued pursuant to Security Council resolutions 2206 (2015), 2271 (2016), 2280 (2016) and 2290 (2016) concerning counter-terrorism.

All Pakistan missions abroad have been asked to fully implement all aspects of the updated Order in the context of the relevant Security Council resolutions. The missions have been further advised that, if any mission is approached by any listed individual, that information should be shared immediately with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of the Interior.
