NOTE

The resolutions of the Security Council, numbered in accordance with a system adopted in 1964, are published in yearly volumes of *Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council*. The new system, which has been applied retroactively to resolutions adopted before 1 January 1965, became fully operative on that date.

SEVENTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVENTH MEETING

Held in New York on Monday, 17 June 1974, at 10.30 a.m.

President: Mr. Moulaye EL HASSEN (Mauritania).

Present: The representatives of the following States: Australia, Austria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, China, Costa Rica, France, Indonesia, Iraq, Kenya, Mauritania, Peru, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United Republic of Cameroon and United States of America.

The meeting was called to order at 10.50 a.m.

Admission of new Members

Application of Grenada for admission to membership in the United Nations (S/11311)

1. The PRESIDENT (*interpretation from French*): I should like to recall that rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Council provides that, unless the Council decides otherwise, the President shall refer requests for admission to the Committee on the Admission of New Members for consideration.
2. Consequently, and unless there is any contrary proposal, I shall request the Committee to consider the application for admission from Grenada and to report on this matter to the Council as soon as possible.

3. If I hear no objection, I shall take it that the Council decides that we should proceed in this way.

It was so decided.

4. The PRESIDENT (*interpretation from French*): The time and place of the meeting of the Committee on the Admission of New Members will be set without delay in consultation with members of the Council.

5. The PRESIDENT (*interpretation from French*): Before adjourning the meeting, I should like, in a few words, to discharge a duty, namely, that of wishing our colleagues who are about to leave us every success in the discharge of their future responsibilities.

6. I am sure that all delegations seated here will regret the departure of our friends and colleagues, Ambassador El-Shibib, of Iraq, and Ambassador Smirnov, of the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic. The very active and fruitful contribution which those representatives have ceaselessly brought to our deliberations will not be forgotten, because they were so outstanding in their consistency and their moral inspiration. I am sure that in their new posts Ambassador El-Shibib and Ambassador Smirnov will continue to render outstanding service not only to their countries but to the United Nations.

7. I know that I am conveying the feelings of members of the Security Council when I say to our colleagues that we shall preserve a very pleasant memory of the relations we have had with them and when I express to them our most sincere and friendly wishes for every success in the future.
