THE SITUATION IN CYPRUS

REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON HIS MISSION OF GOOD OFFICES IN CYPRUS
(S/23121)

The PRESIDENT: The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them the report of the Secretary-General (S/23121) on his mission of good offices in Cyprus. They also have before them a draft resolution (S/23137) which has been prepared in the course of the Council's consultations.

I should like to draw the attention of the members of the Council to a technical correction to be made to the draft resolution. In operative paragraph 3, the words "and non-alignment of the Republic of Cyprus" should be followed by a semicolon instead of a comma.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. Unless I hear any objection, I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

There being no objection, it is so decided.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour: Austria, Belgium, China, Côte d'Ivoire, Cuba, Ecuador, France, India, Romania, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Yemen, Zaire, Zimbabwe

The PRESIDENT: There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 716 (1991).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on the agenda.
