### OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUÉ OF THE 4058TH MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters,  
New York, on Tuesday, 26 October 1999, at 10 a.m.

At its 4058th meeting, held in private on 26 October 1999, the Security Council considered the situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The representatives of Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hungary, India, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Luxembourg, Malta, Mexico, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Singapore, Slovakia, South Africa, Sweden, Turkey and Ukraine were invited, at their request, to participate in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

The Security Council heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Jacques Paul Klein, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Coordinator of United Nations Operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The members of the Council made comments and posed questions in connection with the briefing. Mr. Klein responded to the comments and questions posed by members of the Council.
