Second report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Preliminary Deployment in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (S/1999/1116)

**The President:** I should like to inform the Council that I have received a letter from the representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, in

which he requests to be invited to participate in the discussion of the item on the Council's agenda. In conformity with the usual practice, I propose, with the consent of the Council, to invite that representative to participate in the discussion, without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

There being no objection, it is so decided.

At the invitation of the President, Mr. Mwamba Kapanga (Democratic Republic of the Congo) took a seat at the Council table.

**The President:** The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda. The Council is meeting in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

Members have before them the second report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Preliminary Deployment in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, document S/1999/1116.

Members of the Council also have before them document S/1999/1130, which contains the text of a draft resolution prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

I should like to draw the attention of members of the Council to document S/1999/1076, which contains the text of a letter dated 18 October 1999 from Finland, transmitting a statement on the Democratic Republic of the Congo by the Presidency of the European Union on behalf of the European Union.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution (S/1999/1130) before it. Unless I hear any objection, I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

There being no objection, it is so decided.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

**The President:** There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 1273 (1999).
