Official communiqué of the 4505th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday, 2 April 2002, at 7.20 p.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 4505th meeting, held in private on 2 April 2002, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian Question’.
