Official communiqué of the 5144th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Monday,
21 March 2005, at 4 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record.

“At its 5144th meeting, held in private on 21 March 2005, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Georgia’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Georgia and Germany to participate in the discussion of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Jean-Marie Guéhenno, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

“The members of the Council heard a briefing by Mr. Guéhenno.

“The representative of Georgia made a statement.”
