Official communiqué of the 5349th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
19 January 2006, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 19 January 2006, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5349th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in Côte d’Ivoire.

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Jean-Marie Guéhenno, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations, and Colonel Ian Sinclair, Chief of Military Planning Service of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.
