Official communiqué of the 5391st (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday,
21 March 2006, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 21 March 2006, the Security Council, pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B, held its 5391st meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in the Sudan.
