Official communiqué of the 5526th (resumed) (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday,
29 September 2006, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At the resumption of the 5526th meeting, held in private on 29 September 2006, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘The situation in Myanmar’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Myanmar to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Ibrahim Gambari, Under-Secretary-General for Political Affairs.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Gambari and the representative of Myanmar had an exchange of views.”
