The situation in Timor-Leste

Report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste (for the period from 21 September 2010 to 7 January 2011) (S/2011/32)

The President: Under rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I should like to invite the representatives of Australia, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, the Philippines and Timor-Leste to participate in this meeting.

The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2011/86, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by Australia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, China, Colombia, France, Gabon, Germany, India, Japan, Lebanon, Malaysia, New Zealand, Nigeria, the Philippines, Portugal, the Russian

Federation, South Africa, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2011/32, which contains the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste.

I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, China, Colombia, France, Gabon, Germany, India, Lebanon, Nigeria, Portugal, Russian Federation, South Africa, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America

The President: The draft resolution received 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 1969 (2011).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda.
