The President (*spoke in French*): The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2012/115, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by Guatemala.

I wish to draw the attention of Council members to documents S/2012/112 and S/2012/113, which contain, respectively, a letter dated 23 February 2012 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council and a letter dated 27 February 2012 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Azerbaijan, China, Colombia, France, Germany, Guatemala, India, Morocco, Pakistan, Portugal, Russian Federation, South Africa, Togo, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America

The President (*spoke in French*): There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2038 (2012).

The Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda.
