Official communiqué of the 6802nd (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Tuesday, 10 July 2012, at 3.45 p.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 10 July 2012, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6802nd meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Operation in Côte d’Ivoire.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Albert Koenders, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in Côte d’Ivoire via video teleconference.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Koenders and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
