Official communiqué of the 6927th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
28 February 2013, at 10 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 6927th meeting, held in private on 28 February 2013, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘Implementation of the note by the President of the Security Council (S/2010/507)’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Afghanistan, Albania, Algeria, Angola, Benin, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Burundi, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Côte d’Ivoire, Croatia, Cuba, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Estonia, Gabon, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, Grenada, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Ireland, Japan, Kyrgyzstan, the People’s Republic of Laos, Lesotho, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Madagascar, Malawi, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Mongolia, Montenegro, Myanmar, Namibia, Nepal, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Nicaragua, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Poland, Romania, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, Slovenia, Somalia, South Africa, Spain, the Sudan, Switzerland, the Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkey, the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Yemen and Zambia to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council’s prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure to the representative of the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations.

“The members of the Council had an exchange of views.”
