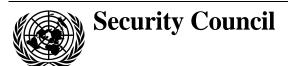

Official communiqué of the 6989th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 27 June 2013, at 10 a.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"On 27 June 2013, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6989th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

"The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Edmond Mulet, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations, and Major General Delali Johnson Sakyi, Force Commander of United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

"Members of the Council, Mr. Mulet, Major General Sakyi and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views."
